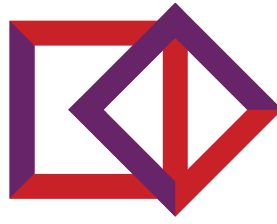
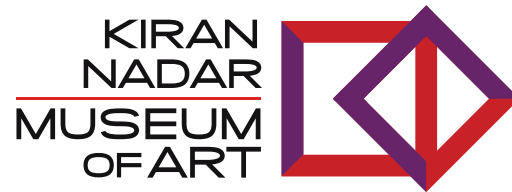

S. H. Raza

Sayed Haider "S. H." Raza was born in 1922 in Babaria, Madhya Pradesh. He completed his education from Sir J. J. School of Art in Mumbai, 1943-47. Raza moved to France to study at the Ecole nationale superieure des Beaux-Arts, Paris in 1950.

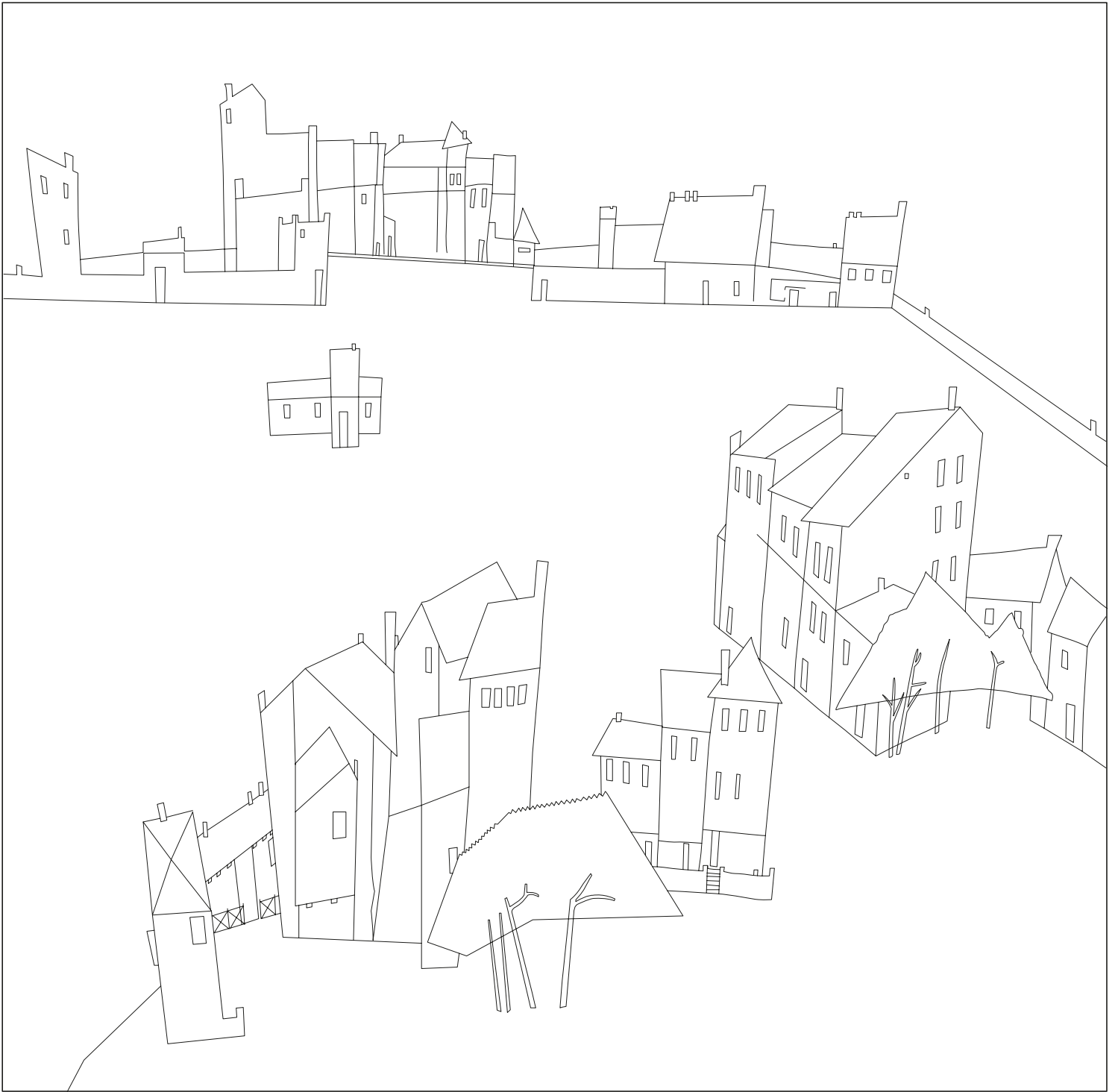
A founder member of the Progressive Artists' Group along with artists like F.N. Souza and K.H. Ara, Raza held his first exhibition with the group in 1948. He was the first non-French artist to receive the Prix de la critique in Paris in 1956.

Recipient of the Commandeur de la Legiond' Honneur, France in 2015; Raza was awarded the Padma Vibhushan in 2013 and Padma Bhushan in 2007. He received the Kalidas Samman from the Government of Madhya Pradesh in 1992-93, Padma Shri & Lalit Kala Akademi Fellowship in 1981.

He passed away in 2016 in New Delhi.
